Nagal enters Perugia Challenger semis

Perugia (Italy): Sumit Nagal continued his splendid form by entering the semi-final of the ongoing Perugia Challenger here on Friday. The sixth-seeded Indian overcame the challenge from the unseeded Maks Kasnikowski of Poland in the quarterfinal, winning in straight sets 6-4, 7-5. This is his eighth successive win since the start of Heilbronn Challenger in Germany. In the semi-final on Saturday, he will be taking on the winner of the other quarterfinal clash between the unseeded Bernabé Zapata Miralles of Spain and second seed László Djere of Serbia. Earlier in the event, Nagal had been victorious against the unseeded Nemanja Fatić of Bosnia and Herzegovina in the opening round before being successful against the unseeded Alessandro Giannessi of Italy in the pre-quarterfinal. Nagal is coming off a title triumph during the Heilbronn Challenger last week, which happens to be his second Challenger title this season after the Chennai Challenger in February.

Strikers Jadhav, Humbe shine with 5 goals

Mumbai: Opportunistic strikers Mayur Jadhav and Sanket Humbe, both scored five goal each in leading Shastri Nagar FC and Feugo Tormento to emphatic victories respectively in First Division matches of the Mumbai Football Association (MFA) League 2023-2024, played at the Neville D'Souza ground, Bandra on Friday. Dashing striker Jadhav cashed in on the chances that came his way and powered Shastri Nagar to a massive 7-0 win against Kenkre FC Under-17. Jadhav's teammates Nikhil Singh and Vinod K. chipped in with a goal apiece to complete the winning margin. Later, Sanket Humbe was also in great scoring form and steered Feugo Tormento to a 6-0 win against Rizvi Ceramics in another one-sided encounter. Tanveer Madaan added the sixth goal to seal the win. Meanwhile, Rakesh Bharat notched up a hat-trick to lead Jupiter SC to a 5-0 win against Classic SC. Elton D'Souza struck the other two goals to round-off the winning tally. Korda stumbles again in 1st event

Gran Rapids (USA): Nelly Korda stumbled again Thursday in her first event since missing the cut in the U.S. Women's Open, dropping four strokes on the first three holes in a 4-over 76 at the windy Meijer LPGA Classic. The top-ranked Korda was tied for 133rd in the 144-player field, 11 strokes behind leader Alison Lee at Blythefield Country Club. Korda shot 80-70 - making a 10 on a hole in the first round - two weeks ago in the U.S. Women's Open in Pennsylvania. She came into the Women's Open with six victories in her last seven tournaments, including a major that tied her LPGA Tour record for five wins in a row. On Thursday at Blythefield, where she won in 2021 at a tournament-record 25 under, Korda opened double bogey-bogey-bogey. Playing in the afternoon in a group with fellow past champions Brooke Henderson and Leona Maguire, Korda was even par the rest of the way, offsetting three bogeys with three birdies.

Indian challenge ends in Aus Open

Sydney: India's top ranked singles player HS Prannoy went down to higher-ranked Kodai Naraoka of Japan 19-21, 13-21 as none among the country's shuttlers failed to progress beyond the quarterfinals of the Australian Open Super 500 event here on Friday. The world No. 10 Prannoy was the latest to be eliminated on a day when his singles compatriot Sameer Verma, mixed doubles pair of Sikki Reddy and B Sumeeth Reddy along with Aakarshi Kashyap in women's singles also drew blank. Prannoy made a rally from being 10-16 down to level the proceedings at 18-all before taking a one-point lead but Naraoka held his nerves to seal the first game. Naraoka was far superior in the second game as he suddenly upped the ante at 5-5 without giving Prannoy any scope of a comeback to seal the match in little more than an hour.

Young Kreishh at take-off point

Mumbai lad is youngest Indian to qualify for Pro Snooker Tour

The brightest young prospect on the Indian snooker scene currently is **Kreishh Gur-baxani**, who has qualified for the highly competitive World Pro Snooker Tour and in the process becoming the youngest Indian to do so at age 21.

The Mumbai lad, who is a Khar Gymkhana cueist, had beaten Pakistan's Muhammad Naseem Akhtar in the final round of the 2024 Asia Oceania Q-School (Event-2) Professional Tour Qualifier event in Bangkok. He did so by winning four successive

frames to take the game and clinch his Pro Snooker Tour spot.

"Obviously, it's unbelievable. It's like a dream. All you think about when you start the sport is to become a professional snooker player. It still hasn't sunk in yet for me," said a beaming Kreishh in an exclusive chat with the Free Press Journal.

Kreishh's inception into the sport began at age nine when his elder brother got him into the billiards room for a casual hit on the pool table.

"Obviously I didn't know how to play but I got glued to it. Then I would go into the snooker room and started playing pool and played that for one and a half years. Shifted to snooker when my height was suitable to play snooker."

At the age of 11 is when he came under the coaching tutelage of two-time Asian Snooker champion Yasin Merchant.

Under Merchant's coaching, Kreishh grew by leaps and bounds honing his craft



and polishing his skills to shine at the highest levels of the sport.

"He has been the main person that has been behind my success whatever I have achieved till now. He's taught me how to play the game and


